BONDI NIPPERS (U6's to U14's)

Season 2010/2011

Dear Nipper Families,

Hard to believe but it's time to start thinking about Nippers again, with registrations mid-September and the first day of Nippers in October. This year we will keep you up-to-date with regular e-mails, so please make sure you give us your current e-mail address and advise us if your e-mail changes. In a similar way, please keep your mobile phone contact number up-to-date too. For those who don't use e-mail, all notes and hard copies of e-mails will be on display on the Nipper noticeboard, just outside the Nipper room inside the clubhouse. **Please read this letter carefully as it explains all you have to do to register both**

returning and new Nippers for the forthcoming season. We have made a few changes this year, including credit card facilities for payment (Visa or MasterCard only). Due to increased costs, we have to increase fees slightly this year. This is the first fee increase in several years. In an attempt to streamline registration and make things easier for families, proficiency swims will be held during the first few Nipper sessions. In response to demand, we will be offering swimming costumes from TYR as well as our regular supplier this season. There will also be more items for sale in the uniform shop, which will again be open every Sunday morning. Nipper clothing will also be on sale on Registration Days (12th and 19th September 2010). **Bondi Nippers will commence at 9 am on Sunday 10th October 2010.**

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR THE 2010/11 SEASON – Returning Nippers

There are three ways to register this season:

1. Complete and sign the registration forms for your child/children, and mail them back, along with payment (cheque or credit card) to:

2. On-line payment – <http://pay.slsa.com.au>. Choose Bondi Surf Bathers, and enter the transaction (membership fee) for each child. It is important you enter each child separately, though it can be done on the same page. The completed registration forms **must still be mailed to Juli Owen**, along with the Registration Payment Details form which is enclosed.

3. Come to the Club with the completed forms on either of the Registration Days, which will be held on Sunday, 12 September from 2 – 4 pm or Sunday, 19 September from 2 – 4 pm.

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR THE 2010/11 SEASON –New Nippers

If you wish to register a new Nipper, please print off a registration form from the Bondi Surf Bathers Life Saving Club website (www.bondisurfclub.com). This form can be mailed to Juli Owen (address above), and you can pay in advance. This payment can be by cheque or credit card, or on-line, as described above. Alternatively, come to one of the Registration Days (Sunday, 12 September from 2 – 4pm or Sunday, 19 September from 2 – 4 pm). **Proof of age (passport, birth certificate, etc.) is required for all new children.** This must be shown on Registration Day or at the first Nippers session.

FEES FOR THIS SEASON

1. For returning Nippers, the fee will be \$90 for the first child and \$50 for each subsequent child.

2. For new registrations, the fee will be \$90 for the first child and \$50 for each subsequent child.

HOW DO I COMPLETE THE FORMS

1. Check the attached form, make changes as required and sign both the front and back of the form. Please write legibly and highlight changes.

2. Make sure to correct the e-mail and mobile phone details, if necessary.

3. Circle your child's shirt and short size on the form.

4. Send the Registration form and the Registration Payment Details form to Juli Owen (address above). If you decide to make an on-line payment, you will still need to return the completed forms.

2010-2011 MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

It appears that some of you may not have received your renewal reminder or are having some problems with the on-line renewal and payment gateway. You basically have **THREE things to do... RENEW, UPDATE DETAILS, PAY FEES.**

Some people are doing one and not the others, i.e., renewing and not paying or paying and not clicking the renew field or updating and not renewing or paying. Go to www.lifesavingonline.com.au and follow the prompts to register, you choose your own username and password. Once registered you need to **RENEW** your membership, check through your details to make sure they are correct, click the acceptance in two places and **SUBMIT** your acceptance, you then choose **PAY ON LINE** and continue with your payment by credit card and if you are unsure of amounts there is a price list you can click on.

If you follow these steps you are not required to sign an SLSA membership form, however, we were recently advised that a Working with Children Check Form still needs to be completed and signed each year. This is a government requirement and cannot be completed electronically. When your renewal and payment is confirmed we will send you an email with the form attached for your completion and return at your convenience. A form is also attached, please see attached documents.

PLEASE NOTE: If the email address you are using is different to the email address we have listed for you on the SurfGuard database, you will not be able to proceed. You will need to contact the office (9300 9270) to have this changed so they match. This authentication is performed to ensure the privacy of your information.

You will be emailed a link for security purposes that you must click on to activate your account. You may then log in and access your details and pay online.

Of course, if you wish to renew and pay your membership manually, please contact the club office as usual on 9300 9279. We look forward to hearing from you soon.
