Things are looking up for the Bondi Craft Team.

The Bondi Craft Team attending their first competition at North Cronulla Open Carnival on Saturday 19 December 2009. The results were positive with Anthony Pledger finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the U19 ski and Adriel Young leading Bondi to a 4<sup>th</sup> place in the Open Ski Relay. Adriel left Australian Kayak Team members in his wake as he tagged Anthony Pledger in first position for the second leg of the relay.

Another promising sign from this carnival was four U17 competitors attending. This was great to see and hopefully with good coaching and hard training these guys can achieve some good results this season. Full results are listed below.

After the Christmas break a reduced team due to holidays, headed to Queenscliff. This carnival showed that craft competition is alive and well in the Sydney region with 100 open ski paddlers competing. The team managed to get two teams out of three in the Open Double Final and one team in the Open Ski Relay final after Greg Byrnes beat the North Bondi competitor in a sprint to the line in the semi final. Full results are below.

Part of the Masters team headed to the East Coast Masters Championships at Collaroy on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2010 with many competitors backing up from Queenscliff on Saturday. The results were excellent with Louise Santos winning 3 from 3 in her age group, Daniel Kelton winning silver in the 30-34 ski and Grant Veckranges winning gold in the 50-54 ski and bronze in the 30-34 double ski with Ben Sutherland.
