If anyone has borrowed any Nipper boards or equipment, please return as soon as possible. Boards may be signed out to individuals for training, but only with the permission of the BOJA.
- Please be considerate! Parking is not permitted in front of the boat-shed, or in the BBQ area.
- Adults are not to use Nipper Boards (of any kind!). They are not designed to take the weight of an adult, and as a result are being damaged. Only Proficient Bronze Medallion holders are permitted to use any of the Club Rescue Boards.

- Nippers Board Training – As you are now aware... Wednesday afternoon Nipper Board training sessions have been postponed until further notice.
