MARCH PAST NEWS

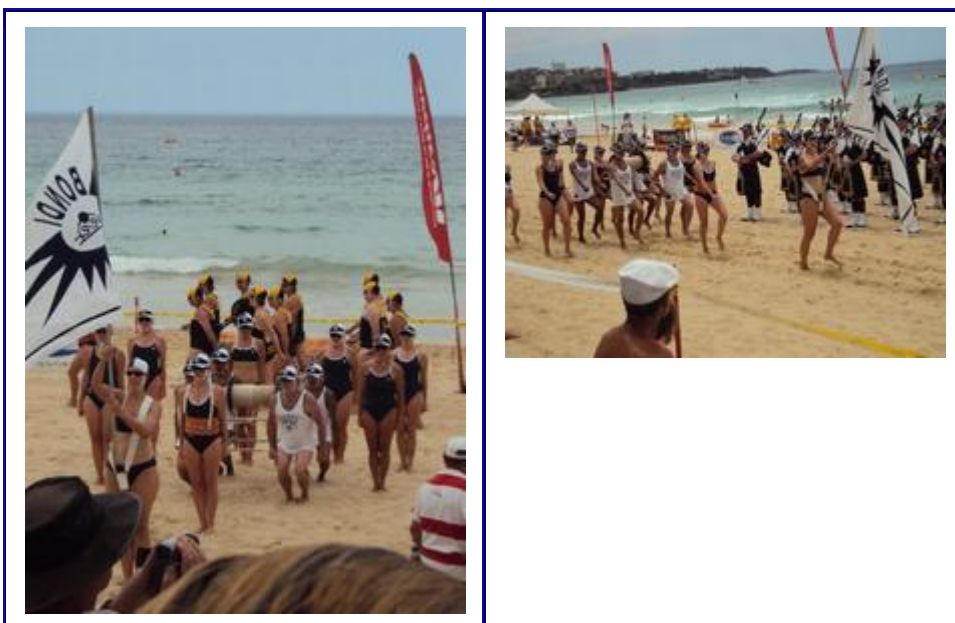

VALE - LONG SERVICE MEMBER, MURRAY TATE

Bondi SBLSC and Australian Rugby are today mourning the loss of the 1951-54 Wallaby flyhalf and inside centre Murray Tate who passed away in Sydney last night. Murray joined Bondi SBLSC in August, 1944.

Murray, who was aged 82 when he died after a three-month illness, played eight Test matches for Australia during an international career which saw him tour both New Zealand and South Africa with the Wallabies.

He was a member of the 1952 Australian side which beat New Zealand 14-9 at Christchurch in the first Test, before the All Blacks squared the series by winning the return match 15-8 in Wellington .

Murray had made his Test debut a year earlier against the All Blacks, becoming the 386th player to wear the Wallaby jersey when he featured in the Australian side that fell 16-6 in the third and final Test of the series at the Brisbane Cricket Ground.

Playing alongside Mr Tate at his debut was the 1946-57 Wallaby halfback Cyril Burke, who passed away 11 days ago. The pair were also team-mates on Australia's 1953 tour of South Africa ,where Mr Tate featured in the opening test of the series at Ellis Park in Johannesburg which the Springboks won 25-3.

As well as his three Tests against the All Blacks, and one against South Africa , Murray played four Tests against Fiji in Australia , featuring in the 1952 and 1954 series between the two countries.

Both series were squared one match apiece, with Murray scoring the sole try of his Test career during Australia's 22-19 win at the Exhibition Ground in Brisbane in 1954.

Murray Tate is survived by his wife Margaret; five sons: Jim, Robert (Bob), Michael, Paul and Peter, and daughter Catherine.

Bob, Jim and Peter are current Long Service members of our Club.

The funeral for Murray will be held at Our Lady of Sacred Heart in Randwick on **Monday 1 February starting at 2pm.** At **4.30 pm** there will be a Celebration of Murray's life held at Eastern Suburbs Rugby Union Club (where Murray was a life member). Members are encouraged to attend.
