Brilliant double for local in Bondi ocean swims

Local Tom Miller last Sunday scored a brilliant double, winning both the one-kilometre and 2.1km ocean swims in the Beach Road Hotel Bondi Bluewater Challenge. Miller caught a small wave to shrug off the threat from another Bondi lifesaver, Lochie Hinds, to take out the one-kilometre race by seven seconds. He then backed up an hour later, coming from third place with two-thirds of the 2.1km race over a triangular course in Bondi Bay completed, to cross the finish

line two seconds ahead of Ryan Huckle, from Bellevue Hill, who has been one of the season's top ocean swim performers. Brad Horrey, of Botany, made it a clean sweep for Eastern Suburbs swimmers, taking third place three seconds behind Huckle. Miller's win of the one-kilometre race was a repeat of last year, when he also won over the shorter distance before the longer race was cancelled because of dangerous surf conditions. To cap-off an outstanding day for Bondi lifesavers, Dori Miller and Louise Stevenson swam the fastest times in the two races for elite women swimmers. A combined total of 549 swimmers entered the two races, which supported Cure Cancer Australia with a percentage of the entry fees donated to its Can Too charity. The Bondi races were the last of the season's Olympus Tough Fine Ocean series organised by Ocean Swims NSW.
