CARNIVAL ENTRIES;

Entries are covered by the club and are expensive so please make sure you race if entered. To enter, visit the office to meet with Viv and review the carnival program before submitting your entries.

Please start to consider your desired events and fellow team members you wish to compete with. We'll need to now on or by the 13th of November so we can appropriately cater for Freshwater carnival.

After the Club Championships and through-out the day, Gary Emmerton, Grant Veckranges and Stephen De Lo Renzo will record your desired event and advise you accordingly. **After the Carnival (Sunday 13th November), there will be a General Masters Meeting @ 3pm upstairs in the bar.** This is important to attend as you will be able to discuss upcoming events and registration.
