All the best for the New Year and may your board skills expand and multiply!

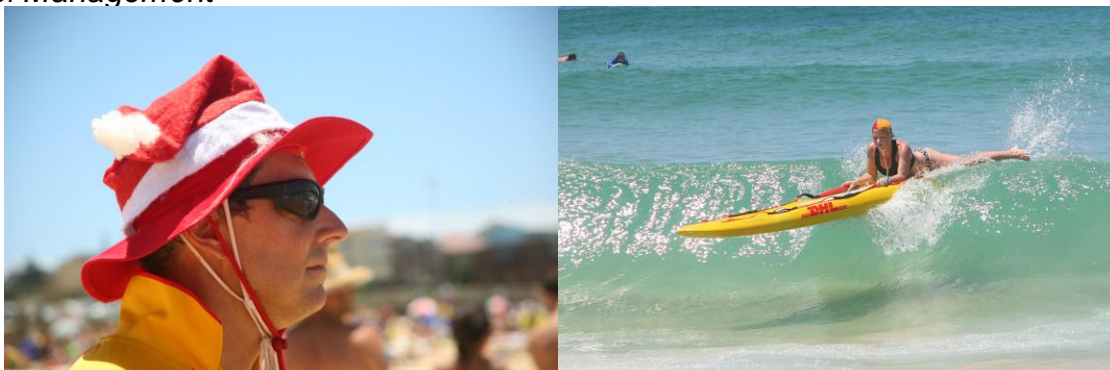
A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD
