

<b>ATTEND PATROL &amp; CLUB</b>	During the period from now to 1 December, all Patrolling Members, Trainers, Assessors, Facilitators, Support Operations Members, Age Managers, Water Safety and those interacting with groups and teams such as education squads, who are eligible to be safely vaccinated must be doubly vaccinated, unless they are exempt on medical grounds.
	All of the information below is for those who have been fully vaccinated, ie. 2 shots of AZ/Pfizer/Moderna. To participate in any club activities you will need to send the office your vaccination certificate to allow your tag to be activated. You can also attend the office to show a paper certificate. This information will be stored securely in Surfguard.
	The craft room and boatshed will be opened for fully vaccinated members living within 5km to access craft. No more than 5 people can be in the boatshed at any time, and you must maintain social distancing, scan in with QR code, and wear a mask while inside
<b>From October 11th - 70% vaccination in NSW</b>	
<b>PATROLS</b>	Patrols will move to 20 fully vaccinated members. SRCs may patrol if they have been vaccinated. Note the 5km and LGA of Concern designations are expected to be removed at that time, with travel allowed in the Greater Sydney area, so all vaccinated members may patrol. At this stage, masks will not be mandatory outdoors, but will still be needed inside the tunnel and clubhouse.
<b>EDUCATION</b>	Bronze squads, SRC squad, and IRB Driver training will commence for fully vaccinated trainers and students
<b>SURF SPORTS</b>	Training sessions for board, yellow board, ski, beach sprints and the 'love squad' can recommence for up to 20 vaccinated members per group
<b>GYM</b>	The gym will be open to financial vaccinated gym members with a maximum of 20 people at any one time.
<b>SILVER SALTIES</b>	Silver Salties may recommence programs for groups of up to 20 fully vaccinated participants
<b>PILATES AND ZUMBA</b>	Pilates, Zumba will recommence with maximum class sizes of 20
<b>CLUB</b>	There will be Sitting <b>Bottles</b> for up to 70 people on the 17th October - this will require attendees to be fully vaccinated and pre-booking, more information will be provided on this event soon. All areas of the club (except steam room) will be reopened to fully vaccinated members; this will include the hall, office, change rooms & showers, boatshed, and craft room. <b>MASKS will need to be worn while inside the club.</b>

### From end October - 80% vaccination in NSW

- Community sport, including Nippers and Surf Sports will be allowed. More information will be provided on start dates closer to October 30.
- -Standing will be allowed at Bottles
- As you can see all of these changes only apply to fully vaccinated members. Members from 12 years old upwards can access vaccination through an expanding network of doctors, pharmacies and vaccination hubs - [get bookings here](#)
- Thank you to all members for keeping the club safe over the lockdown period. We look forward to reopening, but please remember that we will still need to use QR codes, wear masks while indoors, wash hands, maintain hygiene and keep social distancing for the immediate future.
